The total column shows the number of applications awaiting an eligibility determination as of close of business the Thursday of the week shown. Awaiting documentaiton from customer means that while the customer submitted an application, by regulation and policy DHS requires more information from that customer to verify eligibility and make a determination. In progress means that DHS beleives it has enough information to make an eligibility determination, but may still need to evaluate additional information provided by the client. For SNAP, this data does not include whether an interview has taken place, a step that is also required for a final eligibility determination.
